**Duty station: In the Rwenzori region**

**Overall purpose of the job:** The job holder will be responsible for providing training and advisory services to farmers on improved agricultural production, agro based enterprise development, agro ecological farming practices and Integrated Water Resources Management.

### **Specific responsibilities:**

- Provide training and technical advisory services to farmers and farmer institutions in appropriate agricultural production methods, household food security and marketing
- Develop community strategies and approaches that empower and ensure involvement of the target program beneficiaries in planning, project execution, monitoring and reporting
- Develop the capacities of the target beneficiaries to engage into productive businesses in agriculture, Water and Sanitation
- Monitor and contribute to analysis of evolving seasonal issues affecting production, food security, livelihoods, and programme performance
- Promotion of integrated water resource management approaches and practices for improved ecosystems management
