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SUPPORT PROCESSES FOR VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPHY DOCUMENTATION OF CHANGE STORIES/ SUCCESS STORIES.

Introduction;

JESE is an implementing partner of a 4-year project “Harnessing adaptive capacities of communities through inclusive governance, climate resilient systems and sustainable livelihood development ‘with Financial support from DANIDA through Care international in Uganda.

JESE together with three other partners i.e. Environmental Alert and ACODE and RICE in (West Nile) implements the Strengthening resilience and promoting inclusive governance for women and youth in vulnerable communities (STRENPO) program at CARE-Uganda level.

Joint Effort to Save the effort (JESE) is mainly responsible for organizing and facilitating the community-based actions to enhance climate change adoption and resilience and inclusive Governance in Natural resources in Kyenjojo and Kyegegwa districts including the refugees.

With the different project interventions for promoting economic empowerment, natural resources governance and climate smart interventions, JESE has registered a number of successes from the project beneficiaries that are worth documenting.

Under the STRENPO project, JESE focuses on promoting economic empowerment especially to the women and youth adjacent to the natural resources. This has been promoted through the Village Savings and Loans Association approach. Currently there are about 100 VSLA groups with a maximum of 30 members in Kyegegwa, Kyenjonjo and Kyaka II settlement. The groups members have been taken through business planning (Selection planning and management of IGAs SPM-IGAs) to enable them budget and invest the money wisely.

In efforts to promote climate change resilience, the Farmer field business schools approach has been applied to ensure sustainable agriculture practices, market engagement, gender and equity, food and nutrition, security, group empowerment and monitoring and evaluation – to build the

knowledge, skills, and practices of farmers. practices through hands on and community driven/enterprise management.

In natural resources governance, JESE has aimed at formation of Collaborative Forest Management and agreements with NFA have been signed. The communities adjacent to the forests have been equipped with knowledge and skills on the access, user and benefit rights. The district and sub-county officials have also been involved in environment protection and restoration activities of JESE.

Therefore, JESE is looking for a consultant to capture success/ impact stories of the project interventions i.e natural resources governance, women and youth empowerment and climate change resilience in Kyegegwa, Kyenjojo and Kyaka II settlement.

Specific Activities/Objectives;

1. To capture success/ impact stories in short video form of 3-5 minutes of the different project interventions i.e women empowerment (economic and leadership), youth empowerment and climate change resilience in Kyenjojo, Kyegegwa and Kyaka II settlement.
2. To capture communicating photographs of the project successes and best practices of VSLA, FFBS in Kyenjojo, Kyegegwa and Kyaka II settlement.

Methodology and approaches

The JESE staff shall provide a script on the interested areas to guide in the capturing of the success/impact stories.

On site visits shall be made to selected project beneficiaries under economic empowerment, natural resources governance and climate change resilience to capture their success/ impact stories under these different project approaches.

Interviews shall be held with project beneficiaries to share and capture their success/impact stories under the different project approaches.

Pictures will be captured and a phot album shall be made to display the project successes under VSLA, FFBS, CFMs and wetland management structures.

Expected outputs/Deliverables

1. 4 short videos of 3-5 minute informative documentaries of project successes and impact stories from project beneficiaries
2. A photo album containing communicating pictures of the project successes and impact stories of project beneficiaries.
3. Consent forms of the project beneficiaries interviewed.

Timeframe

The assignment is planned to be undertaken in a period of 14 working days from the date of signing the contract. If there are changes that might arise beyond the consultants control, an additional of 07 working shall be granted to successfully accomplish the assignment. This shall be formal request by the consultant.

Required competencies;

1. A minimum of 3 years of proven experience in documentary /film and photography production
2. Good technical photography and videography skills.
3. Must be creative, passionate about creating stories or messages through film and video (along with editing video) and have an eye for detail.
4. Able to produce high quality broadcast on tight deadlines on a variety of different issues and subject matter.

Technical requirements

Broadcast quality full HD video, 1920 x 1080p

Professional sound recording at minimum of 96 kHz/24-bit

HD web files and HD DVD as final products.
